

HOME VIBRATION NUMBER GUIDE

A quick reference for exploring the energetic themes of a home.

Use the calculator at HouseByTheNumbers.com, or reduce the street number to a single digit.

Use this as a reflection tool, not a rulebook. Let the number start the conversation, then trust your lived experience. If the energy of a home feels off, know that it can be intentionally shifted.

Note: If your number reduces to 11, 22, or 33, pause before reducing it further. Read the master number page first, then the single-digit root shown below: 11/2, 22/4, or 33/6.

| 1 | The Pioneer: Independence, fresh starts, self-trust | Create a focus zone for goals or new beginnings. Keep the entryway clear and intentional. |
| 2 | The Harmonizer: Partnership, peace, emotional connection | Soften shared spaces. Add pairs, cozy seating, calming colors, and places for conversation. |
| 3 | The Creative: Expression, joy, beauty, communication | Let personality show. Add art, color, music, play, or a space for creative projects. |
| 4 | The Foundation: Stability, structure, security, roots | Strengthen the basics. Focus on repairs, routines, storage, and organization. |
| 5 | The Catalyst: Change, movement, freedom, flexibility | Keep pathways open. Avoid overcrowding and create a grounded home base for active energy. |
| 6 | The Nurturer: Care, family, beauty, belonging | Nurture the heart of the home. Add warmth, comfort, gathering space, and a place to recharge. |
| 7 | The Sanctuary: Reflection, intuition, solitude, inner knowing | Create quiet corners. Add soft lighting, books, texture, privacy, or space for stillness. |
| 8 | The Powerhouse: Abundance, ambition, leadership, self-worth | Strengthen command spaces. Pay attention to the front door, office, desk, money areas, and flow. |
| 9 | The Completion: Release, compassion, wisdom, transition | Clear what is complete. Honor memories, refresh the space, and make room for what's next. |

MASTER NUMBERS

Some numbers ask more of us.

In numerology, 11, 22, and 33 are considered master numbers. They carry the root energy of 2, 4, and 6, with a bigger assignment attached.

In a home, a master number can point to a space that supports daily life while also stretching you toward a deeper purpose, a larger vision, or a more conscious way of living.

If your home reduces to a master number, pay attention. The single-digit root still matters, while the master number reveals the higher invitation of the space.
